

Stormwater Management Workshop for Schools: Requirements and Best Practices

Why Attend

NYSDEC and USEPA require stormwater management whenever 1) an acre or more of soil is disturbed* and 2) whenever a property meets their criteria as a designated urbanized area. Districts under construction or planning construction need to comply with filing an NOI (Notice of Intent) and having a SWPPP (Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan) on site. NYSDEC is gearing up to enforce the requirements for the "non-traditional" MS4s (Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems), like school buildings that meet the criteria of a designated urbanized area.

Our speakers, **Carl Thurnau**, Director of Facilities NYSED, **Angus Eaton**, Section Chief NYSDEC and his stormwater staff, and **Ken Barber**, Barber Stormwater Management will:

- ✍ Share methods of compliance with construction stormwater requirements; Capital Projects, State Aid & NOIs.
- ✍ Provide stormwater best practices and post-construction management strategies.
